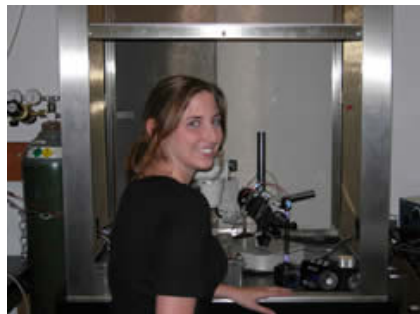


## Summer Research in Neuroscience at Tulane

Tulane students learned that the best way to defeat the heat of a New Orleans summer is to study the brain in the confines of a climate-controlled laboratory. This summer 7 Tulane faculty members hosted 14 students who participated in ongoing research projects in Neuroscience. Advanced undergraduate and masters students gained experience in a wide range of techniques used by Tulane neuroscientists in the 9-week program. Each student received a summer stipend through Tulane's Program in Neuroscience, which offers the B.S., M.S., and Ph.D. degrees. Many of the participating students will continue their research projects in their host laboratories during the coming academic year.
